Conducted by qualified instructors under CAA-approved training standards.

OVERVIEW

This package is aimed at students who wish to commit to the Instrument Rating (Restricted) as part of an approved training programme. The instructor will deliver a structured lesson from the IR (R) syllabus per flight. Lesson choice will depend on his/her assessment of the appropriate lesson (which may be affected by weather conditions at the time of the flight). The choice of aircraft is based on operational conditions and therefore may vary.

Qualified pilots who wish to build instrument flying experience may also benefit from this package.

Landing fees are payable on all flights.

You'll receive a safety briefing appropriate to each flight. The instructor will explain the lesson to be covered before each flight and will outline how the flight will be conducted.

The instructor may handle key stages such as take-off and landing until sufficient skill levels can be demonstrated. The instructor will demonstrate the requirements of each lesson. When safe and appropriate, you'll be invited to take the controls and conduct key parts of the flight. The amount of hands-on time varies depending on conditions and instructor judgement — safety is always the priority. Lessons may be repeated until you have reached the required standard.

AFTER THE FLIGHT

After the flight, your instructor will provide a debrief and help you understand key follow-up steps, such as recording your flight hours in an approved logbook.

SAFETY AND PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS

All flights are conducted under CAA-approved training procedures. Weather and operational conditions are monitored to ensure safety and quality of instruction.
