

NORTH WEST FLIGHT TRAINING

PROFESSIONAL FLIGHT TRAINING • BLACKPOOL AIRPORT

5 Hour Training Block

Conducted by qualified instructors under CAA-approved training standards.

OVERVIEW

This package is aimed at students who wish to book a block of training flights as part of our approved training programme. The instructor will deliver a structured lesson from the PPL syllabus per flight. Lesson choice will depend on his/her assessment of the appropriate lesson (which may be affected by weather conditions at the time of the flight). The choice of aircraft is based on operational conditions and therefore may vary.

Landing fees are payable on all flights.

KEY DETAILS

Duration	300 minutes (maximum) including ground taxi time
Occupants	One passenger in addition to the pilot (subject to weight limits)
Instructor	Licensed flight instructor
Location	Blackpool Airport
Eligibility	Flight time may count toward a pilot licence if aged 14 or older
Certificate	Not provided

BEFORE THE FLIGHT

You'll receive a safety briefing appropriate to the flight. The instructor will explain the lesson to be covered before each flight and will outline how the flight will be conducted.

DURING THE FLIGHT

The pilot will handle key stages such as take-off and landing unless sufficient skill levels have been achieved. The instructor will demonstrate the requirements of each lesson. When safe and appropriate, you'll be invited to take the controls and reproduce what has been taught. The amount of hands-on time varies depending on conditions

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and instructor judgement — safety is always the priority. Lessons may be repeated until you have reached the required standard.

AFTER THE FLIGHT

After the flight, your instructor will provide a debrief and help you understand key follow-up steps, such as recording your flight hours in an approved logbook.

CONTINUING YOUR JOURNEY

If you'd like to continue training, each flight can count toward a Private Pilot Licence (PPL). Your instructor can advise on continuing training options.

SAFETY AND PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS

All flights are conducted under CAA-approved training procedures. Weather and operational conditions are monitored to ensure safety and quality of instruction.

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
