OVERVIEW

This flight is a genuine training experience with a qualified instructor. The instructor will deliver a structured lesson from the PPL syllabus and will aim to ensure you take the controls during the flight (depending on conditions and instructor discretion). Every flight is conducted as part of our approved training programme. Landing fees are payable on any subsequent trial flights.

Duration	60 minutes including ground taxi time
Occupants	One passenger in addition to the pilot (subject to weight limits)
Instructor	Licensed flight instructor
Location	Blackpool Airport
Eligibility	Flight time may count toward a pilot licence if aged 14 or older
Certificate	Available on request after the flight

BEFORE THE FLIGHT

You'll receive a safety briefing covering aircraft procedures, communication, and what to expect during the flight. The instructor will explain how the controls work and outline how the flight will be conducted.

DURING THE FLIGHT

The pilot will handle key stages such as take-off and landing. When safe and appropriate, you'll be invited to take the controls and experience how the aircraft responds. The amount of hands-on time varies depending on conditions and instructor judgement — safety is always the priority. Exercise 4 – Effect of Controls is typically the first lesson covered.
